Indeed, when asked what they liked best about their workplace, employees at top-rated companies were about twice as likely to say they felt "genuinely appreciated" at their job and confident in the direction of the company as they were to talk about pay and benefits they earn for working there.

That's no surprise, said PeteFoley, head of the Employee research Group at human resources consulting firm mercer. It s not that pay cheeks don't matter. Obviously they do. But when it comes to creating enthusiastic, engaged employees, money alone cant buy you love.

Attending a good pre-school and primary school has more impact on children's academic progress than their gender or family background. The Institute of Education study found that the quality of teaching children receive is more important than their gender or family income. A high quality pre-school followed by an academically effective primary school gives children's development a significant boost. But children also need a stimulating early years home- learning environment to build upon.

### PARASITIC AND VIRUTIC DISEASES

Man, like other animals, is ever a host to a great number of parasites: foreign organisms which cling to the skin or live inside the body. Most of these parasites caused us little discomfort, but a few are responsible for serious parasitic diseases, particularly in tropical countries. Malaria and sleeping sickness, for instance- and these are caused by small protozoan parasites consisting of a single cell- are still major causes of death in many parts of the world.
